COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Advanced Pediatric Life Support (APLS) course was developed by the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American College of Emergency Physicians. The course is designed to review assessment and care for acutely ill and injured children. Participants will engage in small group discussions and hands-on simulation. The APLS course at Nemours Children's Hospital is an interactive two-day program (15 hrs CME/CEU) that will allow participants to experience immersive learning, practice with high fidelity simulation, and become more confident in their ability to manage acute care presentations including sepsis, seizures, poisonings, trauma, respiratory, metabolic and cardiac disorders among infants, children, and adolescents. Upon successful completion of the course, the participant will receive the APLS Certificate.

Who Should Take APLS?

- Any physician who treats pediatric patients-Pediatricians, Hospitalists Family Practice, Emergency and Urgent Care Physicians.
- Physicians in training-residents, interns, or fellows who will be expected to provide timely evaluation and treatment to infants, toddlers, school-aged children, and adolescents.
- Nurses, Paramedics, Physician Assistants, and Nurse Practitioners involved in the treatment of pediatric patients, especially in urgent or emergency care settings.

Registration

Learning Objectives:

- Utilize the Pediatric Assessment Triangle to form a general impression of a patient and determine treatment needs.
- Promptly recognize acutely ill child and initiate appropriate treatment.
- Utilize technical skills when responding to pediatric emergencies including bag mask ventilation, endotracheal intubation, intraosseous access, and lumbar puncture.
- Recognize and manage problems in children with special health care needs.
- Plan treatment for both common and life-threatening medical emergencies.
- Demonstrate procedural skills in airway and vascular management.
- Identify injuries and illnesses depicted in diagnostic images.

Accreditation

Nemours is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to provide continuing medical education for physicians.
